



Safety Overview

GENERAL CAMPUS SAFETY

The safety and well-being of our students, staff, and visitors is a top priority. Our campus is equipped with a range of safety measures to ensure a secure environment every day, including:

- 24/7 campus monitoring for safety concerns
- Locked exterior doors with controlled entry during school hours
- Background checks, fingerprinting, and Safe Haven – It's Up to You training for all employees, coaches, and volunteers
- Raptor Software used to screen all campus visitors during the school day
- Over 40 CCTV cameras monitoring activity both inside buildings and around campus
- Comprehensive emergency response plans in place for situations such as lockdowns, evacuations, or weather-related schedule changes



PHYSICAL & EMOTIONAL WELL BEING

We prioritize the physical and emotional well-being of our students through a strong support system and trained staff.

Key components include:

- A dedicated Health Room Attendant available five days a week
- A full-time licensed therapist providing on-campus mental health support
- Annual Mandatory Reporting training for all employees
- Suicide Prevention and Awareness training for all new staff
- CPR and First Aid certification required every two years for all employees
- All coaches are trained in CPR, First Aid, and Concussion Protocol

TRANSPORTATION SAFETY

We are committed to maintaining a safe and orderly environment during all arrival and dismissal times. Our transportation safety measures include:

- Clearly marked and supervised drop-off and pick-up zones for buses and parent vehicles
- An enforced speed limit on all campus roads and parking lots to ensure pedestrian safety
- Staff and volunteers present during arrival and dismissal to direct traffic and assist students
- Designated pedestrian walkways and crosswalks to separate foot traffic from vehicles



DIGITAL & PERSONAL DATA SECURITY

Protecting student and staff information is a critical priority. Our school has implemented strong safeguards and educational practices to ensure digital and personal data security, including:

- Established cybersecurity measures to protect school databases and online platforms from unauthorized access
- Ongoing guidance and education for students on digital citizenship, online safety, cyberbullying, and internet privacy
- A strict retention and disposal policy for paper records containing Personally Identifiable Information (PII)



EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS

We are committed to maintaining a safe and prepared campus through thorough planning, regular training, and strong communication. Our emergency preparedness efforts include:

- Documented safety policies and comprehensive emergency response plans, developed in collaboration with local authorities, to address fires, natural disasters, intruders, unplanned schedule changes, and other emergencies; these plans are reviewed and updated annually
- Monthly emergency drills with all staff and students to practice evacuation, lockdown, secure perimeter, and shelter-in-place procedures
- Reliable communication platforms with built-in redundancy to quickly notify parents/guardians, first responders, and staff in emergency situations or schedule changes (such as weather-related closures)
- HERO protocol training for all employees, equipping staff with the tools and confidence to respond quickly and effectively in crisis situations
