TUITION PAYMENT PLAN OPTIONS

St. Hedwig School requires the use of FACTS for monthly tuition and fee payments.

- Pay in Full: August 5, 2025 payable through FACTS. (FACTS fee waived)
- Eleven Monthly Payments (FACTS charges a \$50 annual fee for this option)
 - July 5, 2025 – May 5, 2026

TUITION POLICY

Tuition payments begin in July for the 2025-2026 school year. Tuition paid is generally nonrefundable. If a withdrawal is necessary due to a transfer out of the area or some other extraordinary event, pending approval by the principal, tuition will be prorated as stated in the Parent/Student Handbook.

PAST DUE TUITION POLICY

It is imperative to meet with the business office when tuition is nearing 60 days past due. The financially responsible parent/guardian must then submit a remedial payment plan in writing to the principal. Families with delinquent tuition may be required to apply for tuition assistance or withdraw their student from the school.



Fees (2025-2026)

SERVICE PROGRAM FAMILY FEE : \$600 – BILLED JUNE 2026

Community and connections are built through service, and our school is stronger for every contribution. We hope everyone who is able will volunteer for a service job.

Families have the opportunity to reduce the Service Fee by opting into the Service Program during registration, and logging hours in the Track-It-Forward app by May 1st. Families opting out of service will be charged the \$600 fee in June.

If you have opted into the Service Program and do not complete and log 60 hours or more by May 1st, you will be billed \$10 per unfulfilled service hour. We appreciate every parent who participates in this program, and rely on attendance to keep school programs running smoothly. Some service jobs do not cover the full 60 hours. In that case, participants will be able to log additional service hours through various volunteer opportunities throughout the school year, such as class hot lunch fundraisers, Autumnfest, and others. Volunteer opportunities will be posted in Celtic Central (our number one source of school communication) and in Track It Forward.

STUDENT FEES (2025-2026) : \$700 – BILLED THROUGH FACTS

Includes Enrollment fee, technology, Diocesan Assessment, textbooks, field trips, yearbook, and licensing fees.

LATE FEES

Payments are due per your chosen payment plan option through FACTS. A \$30 late charge will be assessed for uncollected tuition. FACTS will also charge a \$30 returned item fee.

EXTENDED DAYCARE

Quality care is available both before and after school for students in transitional kindergarten through eighth grade. Registration materials are available in the main school office or at the Extended School Day office.
