# Grade



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### History

Students will learn about American and California history, geography, civics and government functions.

Book: Social Studies Weekly

### Science

Students will be learning environments and living things, life cycles and traits, weather and climate, and forces.

Book: TGI

### ELA

Students will be exposed to different genres of reading and writing. Students will learn the different parts of speech through grammar.

Book: Wonders and Easy Grammar

### Religion

Students will learn to be faithful participants in their Religion through prayer, reading scripture, and familiarizing themselves with the Kingdom of God.

Book: Blest are We

### Math

Students will be able to understand multiplication and division, fractions, adding and subtracting, and classifying geometric shapes.

Book: Big Ideas Math

### GRADING

Everything is graded on a point system. Points may be deducted if directions are not followed, work is incomplete, or if grade level effort is not shown.

Breakdown:

80% Summative Assessments: tests, projects, essays  
20% Formative Assessment: homework, classwork, exit tickets, journaling, etc.

### Absent

Students have as many days as they were absent to complete and turn in their work. Students will have an absent folder on their desk with their work. Please help facilitate them finishing the work.

### Late/Missing Work

There will be a ten point deduction on responsibility if an assignment is not completed or turned in on time. If a student forgets to turn complete a formative assignment, they have until the following Monday to turn it in. If it is not turned in by then, it will remain a zero. Projects not turned in on time will be deducted 5% everyday it is late, up until 50% off, at that point, the student will earn a zero.

### Behavior Expectations

Students start each week with 100% in responsibility. Students will be given a verbal warning for inappropriate behavior before a **stop sign** is earned. A **stop sign** on the desk indicates ongoing issues. A **stop sign** results in point deductions. Students may "start over" at recess and lunch in Trimester 1 and lunch in Trimester 2. A detention is assigned for scores of 65% or below.

### Policies and Procedures

- Students MUST have a free reading book in their bag at all times.
- Students need to be prepared with completed homework and supplies daily.

### Technology

- Students are expected to have a charged chromebook in all classes. 3rd grade is expected to come to school with charged chromebooks
- Cellphones and wearable technology must be turned off and in the box at the start of everyday.

### Uniforms

- Please ensure your child is in proper uniform everyday. This includes the correct uniform, jewelry, shoes, and haircuts
